- 3. CH105 and BIO111 satisfy the Natural and Physical Science Core requirements.
- 4. All allied health majors must take EN100* or EN150* as Power of Language Core and major requirement.
- 5. All Allied Health majors need to take Probability and Statistics (MA 251) in their sophomore year.
- 6. PT students may choose PSY 225 or PSY221.
- 7. Students interested in the 3+3 program with Thomas Jefferson University should see Dr. Coren for potential Core course selections.
