MAJOR: **Biology – Pre-Allied Health Programs (3+2): Bioscience Technologies, Radiologic Sciences, Cardiovascular Invasive Specialty (3+1), Physical Therapy (3+3).**

COURSES REQUIRED BY THE MAJOR

First Semester

- BIO111 – Intro to Biological Sciences I
- CH105 – Fundamentals Of Chemistry
- EN100 or EN150 (see note 4)
- First Year Seminar

Second Semester

- BIO112 – Intro to Biological Sciences II
- CH113 Organic Chemistry I
- MA110, 117 or 121
- Core Requirement (see note 2)

NOTES:

1. Students need to be aware of the differing requirements of the 3+2, and the 3+3 programs, especially as they relate to chemistry and biology courses.
2. All allied health majors must take PSY105* as part of Social Sciences Core/major. PSY105 can be taken during either semester.
3. CH105 and BIO111 satisfy the Natural and Physical Science Core requirements.
4. All allied health majors must take EN100* or EN150* as Power of Language Core and major requirement.
5. All Allied Health majors need to take Probability and Statistics (MA 251) in their sophomore year.
6. PT students may choose PSY 225 or PSY221.
7. Students interested in the 3+3 program with Thomas Jefferson University should see Dr. Coren for potential Core course selections.
