- 2. MA251 is required in the sophomore year. Students should take any necessary prerequisites in the first year depending on their math placement. MA251 is a pre-requisite for BA248 which is taken in the 2nd year.
- 3. BA270 and BA271 are to be taken in the 2nd year. Students should take BA270 in the fall and BA271 in the spring term.
