

FIRST YEAR STUDENT ADVISING SHEET

MAJOR: Economics

COURSES REQUIRED BY THE MAJOR

First Year (either semester)

- EC101 Principles of Macroeconomics
- EC102 Principles of Microeconomics
- MA121 Calculus I

First Year (spring semester)

- BA105 Managerial Communications & Student Career Preparation I
- BA110 Business Orientation
- BA111 First Year Business Experience

NOTES:

1. Students may take EC101 and EC102 in any sequence.
2. Similarly, MA121 may also be taken in any sequence.
3. BA270 and BA271 are to be taken in the 2nd year. Students should take BA270 in the fall and BA271 in the spring term.
4. BA205, BA305, and BA405 are sequence courses that should be taken following BA105 in the first year. Students would take BA205 in the 2nd year, BA305 in the 3rd year, and BA405 in the 4th year.
