NOTES:

1. Incoming first year students will be placed appropriately in either EN 100 or EN 150. Ideally they will take this course the first semester, but it is not necessary that they do so.

- 2. English requires the second semester of a modern or ancient language course at 112 or higher level (if so placed). See the English Department website for more information.
- 3. First year students should take their initial English course at the 200 level; EN 200 and EN 240 are good choices to take second semester, schedule permitting. Advanced first-year students may take EN 220 or EN 230. EN 200 should be taken in the spring of either the first or second year.
- 4. EN 104, EN 101, and EN 180 <u>cannot</u> be counted toward the English major, although each does satisfy a requirement for Core, and EN 180 can count towards a Creative Writing minor.
- 4. English literature majors may also minor in Creative Writing.
