

FIRST YEAR STUDENT ADVISING SHEET

Major: Modern Languages (Spanish)

First Semester (according to placement exam):
Spanish 211, 212 or 300

Second Semester:
Spanish 212 or 300

NOTES:

1. All students with more than two years of Spanish at the high school level must take the online language placement exam (www.etown.edu/modernlanguages) before registering in a language course for academic credit, unless the student begins a new language. ***A student with more than two years of Spanish cannot take SP 111.***
2. To fulfill the major, students must complete 35 hours above the 212 level.
3. Students are required to take four 300 level courses at Elizabethtown College plus a 4 credit senior research project (SP 496/7).
4. Students must complete the four 300 level courses in Spanish by the end of their sophomore year (aside from exceptional circumstances) and demonstrate an oral proficiency rating of intermediate before going abroad.
5. A minimum of 15 credits in the major language must be taken in an approved study abroad program, such as BCA, during the senior year. Specific course requirements to be taken abroad are outlined on the language check sheet. Majors must spend two semesters of study abroad. However, in exceptional circumstances, as specified in the college catalogue, double-majors may apply for a substitution of one semester abroad.
6. Students must complete the Spanish Major Portfolio as a graduation requirement.
7. By the end of the final semester, students must receive an oral proficiency rating of advanced.
