COURSES REQUIRED BY THE MAJOR

## First Semester

 PSY 105 – General Psychology (see note 1, 2)

## **Second Semester**

- PSY 111 (see note 3)
- Students may take a 200-level content course (see note 4)

## NOTES:

- 1. PSY 105 is a pre-requisite to all other psychology courses. We prefer that it be taken in the Fall, but it could also be taken in the Spring semester of the first year.
- 2. An Honors version of PSY 105 will be taught during fall 2015. Incoming Honors students who are intended Psychology majors should have first priority for any remaining seats in this course.
- 3. PSY 111 is a required course, but is not a prerequisite to other Psychology courses. It may be taken at any point over the four years.
- 4. The major requires three 200-level content courses (2 of PSY 221, 226, 227, or 235; 1 of PSY 241 or 251). The major also requires PSY 213 and PSY 218, which students should schedule for their second year.
