Assistant Professor of Social Work

Elizabethtown College invites applications for a full-time, tenure track position in Social Work starting August 2017 to teach courses at all levels of our BSW program. Experience teaching macro practice classes and field seminar are of particular interest. The department seeks candidates with dynamic teaching skills and a passion for social work who can effectively mentor students into the profession. The department also seeks candidates who can contribute to the knowledge base of the profession, and who will contribute in meaningful ways to the diversity and intercultural goals of the College. Elizabethtown College follows the Teacher-Scholar model and course workload is three 4-credit courses per semester. Small class size and individual interaction with students are valued by Elizabethtown faculty. Internal funds and grants are available for scholarship and professional development.

A completed Ph.D. in Social Work is preferred, however candidates who have successfully completed their coursework and qualifying exams and are ABD at the time of application will be considered. Those with a PhD in a closely affiliated field will also be considered. An MSW from a CSWE-accredited institution is required, with at least 2 years of post-MSW practice experience required. Candidates must have teaching experience in higher education and show evidence of a research agenda.

The Social Work Program at Elizabethtown College currently has 75 majors and contributes to minors in Women and Gender Studies, International Studies, and Peace and Conflict Studies. The department prides itself on the high number of required field hours, international opportunities, and close collegial relationships.
