As well, we seek candidates whose expertise complements, rather than duplicates, the department's existing strength in French history. Candidates should be able to contribute survey courses to the College's Core Curriculum program as well as upper division sections in their specialty area. The Department is especially interested in attracting faculty committed to dynamic and innovative classroom instruction. The typical teaching load is 3-3, and faculty are expected to involve students in high-impact practices such as research and internships whenever possible.
