Assistant Professor in Computer Science

Elizabethtown College invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in Computer Science to begin in August 2016.

Applicants must have a Ph.D. in Computer Science, Information Systems, or a closely related field prior to the start date. Preferred candidates will have a strong ability to teach a variety of courses in software engineering, database systems, or data science. Teaching may also include introductory and service Computer Science courses. Preferred candidates will further demonstrate an ability to maintain an active research agenda that includes mentoring undergraduate research projects and experience working with underrepresented student populations.

Located in southeastern Pennsylvania, Elizabethtown College offers its 1,900 students more than 53 academic programs in the liberal arts, sciences and professional studies. Driven by its commitment to Educate for Service, Elizabethtown centers learning in strong relationships, links classroom instruction with experiential learning, emphasizes international and cross-cultural perspectives and nurtures the capacity for lives of purpose and leadership as global citizens. The College is located approximately an hour and a half by car from Baltimore and Philadelphia and two and a half hours from D.C. and New York.
