SUMMARY

The primary purpose of this position is to perform production, service, and utility at dining areas.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Assist in the preparation, production, and service of food items for various food stations for all meal periods during assigned shifts. Duties include but are not limited to line service, cold or hot prep, utility, checker, and catering.
- Responsible for achieving and maintaining a harmonious working relationship with all levels of supervisors, managers, subordinates, administrations, faculty, staff and members of the community at large. Must provide the best customer service at all times.
- Responsible to assist in maintaining the highest level of safety and sanitation for customers, employees, facilities, and equipment. Must ensure that the overall production and service of the operation meets the standards of the department.
