- If a Literature Minor intends to do both courses in either of the British or the American Literature and Culture Survey Sequences, then they should try their best to do them "in order"—i.e., I and then II—because this ordering will enable them to see more clearly the development of, and changes in, literary and cultural traditions.
- 3. EN100, EN101, EN102, EN103, and EN104, and EN150 cannot be counted toward the English Literature Minor; however, all of these courses do satisfy Core requirements.
