 - b. expected duration of the condition
 - c. date of most recent office visit
- 3. Positive and adverse effects of any prescribed medications
- 4. Type, severity, and frequency of symptoms currently experienced by the student and describe how it substantially limits one or more major life activities
- 5. Describe the desired housing accommodations and explain how the request relates to the impact of the condition
- Provide information about how the student will manage these symptoms in other areas of the campus
