Elizabethtown College considers Housing & Residence Life an integral part of a student's development and makes reasonable modifications for students with disabilities. Under ADA, colleges may require external sources of information to further understand the functional limitations of the condition and help make informed decisions about reasonable accommodations. Please submit supporting documentation from your treating healthcare professional if you have not previously done so. Requests for housing accommodations are considered on a case-by-case basis, and the college will prioritize requests based on supporting documented need and availability.

Requests must be submitted and reviewed on a yearly basis and, in some cases, additional or updated documentation may be requested from the treating health care provider. While we try to honor all requests, the College cannot guarantee all accommodations granted for one academic year will be granted for subsequent years. The College expects specific modifications will be the result of an interactive process between the student, Housing & Residence Life, and Disability Services.
