

Pharmacy Services and Prescriptions

Students may keep prescription medications with them in their room. It is recommended that they keep these in a secure location and not accessible to anyone else. Some may choose to bring a lockbox with them to secure their prescription medication. This is recommended but not required.

Pharmacies in the Elizabethtown Area are listed on the Student Health webpage under “Medical Services” and then “Outside Medical Service Providers”.

Delivery to Campus:

Sloans Norlanco Pharmacy has been delivering to campus for many years. This service is free of charge and is offered Monday – Friday. Prescriptions are dropped off at Campus Security and are held securely until the student is able to pick up their medication with their college ID.

To sign up for this service, students will need to establish an account with Sloans. Please call 717-653-6888 and have the following information ready:

1. Insurance policy information
2. Credit or debit card information to keep on file for copayments.

Prescriptions:

Health providers at home may call in prescriptions to local pharmacies and also to Sloans pharmacy if delivery is desired.

Providers at the Penn State Health Medical group/ Student Health office also can assist students with providing ongoing care and prescription refills.

Mail Order Pharmacy:

If students are currently participating in a 90 day mail order pharmacy, they can continue this and have their medications mailed to them at their campus address.
